These items will be collected from the Church on **Holy Saturday morning**. They specifically are asking for:

- 1) Rice (white or brown) (2) Pasta of any kind (3) Tins of tuna fish and sardines (4) Tins of vegetables and soup
- 5) Cooking Oil (6) Tea, Coffee, Sugar (7) Baby items such as nappies, zinc cream etc. (8) Toiletries of any sort such as soap, shampoo etc.
