## World Mission Sunday

World Mission Sunday takes place on the second last Sunday of October each year. Since 1926, the Church has traditionally remembered its universal mission during the month of October. This year Mission Sunday will be celebrated globally on the **23rd October 2016**. The theme is *'Every Christian is a Missionary'*. Throughout the world the faithful will reflect on the universal call to Mission of all the baptised. They will be invited to contribute what they can to support the development and growth of young churches internationally. This special Sunday in October provides Catholics with the opportunity to unite with their missionary sisters and brothers overseas, and to recommit themselves to bringing the Joy of the Gospel to everyone they meet in their daily lives at home and at work. In October and especially on Mission Sunday Catholics are invited to be specially conscious of the Church's missionary activity abroad (Ad Gentes) through prayer, sacrifice and financial contributions. In October 2015, Irish Catholics contributed more than **€1.7 million on Mission Sunday**.
