NEW SCHOOL TERM

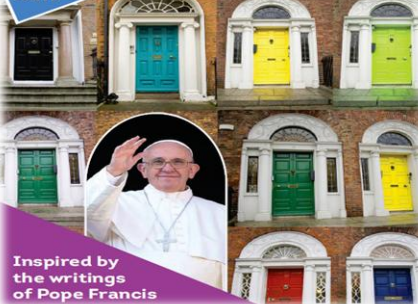
