The sick pilgrims are accommodated close to the Grotto and are cared for by voluntary doctors, nurses and helpers from all over the Diocese. At Easter 30 children travelled to Lourdes with the Dublin Diocesan Children's Pilgrimage. If you have someone at home or know of someone who would benefit from a visit to Lourdes, there are application forms - subject to consideration by the Pilgrimage Medical Board, and the decision as to their acceptance rests with this Board. The fare for sick pilgrims is €480 - specially subsidised and still less than 50% of the actual fare. Many applicants are unable to afford the fare, and without the financial support of the Dublin Diocesan Pilgrimage and, of course, the medical care &amp; volunteers, these sick pilgrims would never have an opportunity to go to Lourdes.
