World Meeting of Families

Pope Francis April 2016

Pope Francis has chosen Ireland to host the 9th World Meeting of Families during 2018. The dates, and theme of the Meeting have been announced by Pope Francis - **Dublin on 22nd to 26th August 2018** and the theme is *"The Gospel of the Family: Joy for the World"*. This is expected to attract thousands of Catholic families from around the globe to Ireland. Hosting a global event of this size require a huge amount of planning and financial outlay on behalf of the host country. Accordingly, Irish bishops have now established a National Finance Committee to provide advice on the financial planning for the World Meeting of Families in Ireland. To support the hosting of the event we intend to hold three national church collections, **the first of which will take place THIS weekend 28/29th May 2016**. The remaining collections will take place in 2017 and 2018. For more information please visit worldmeeting2018.ie - this collection will replace the SHARE (the second) collection next weekend.
